Dear Counselor/Teacher:

The East Point/College Park Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. will award a limited number of scholarships, in the amount of \$1,800 each, to graduating African American male and female high school seniors. Scholarships will be awarded in four categories: **1) Academic:** Scholarships awarded in this category will be based primarily on the students' academic record, including GPA, ACT/SAT scores, and class rigor. **2) Community Service:** Scholarships awarded in this category will be based primarily on the students' record of community service. **3) Leadership:** Scholarships awarded in this category will be based primarily on the students' leadership roles in both school and community. **4) EPCP Educational Development Programs:** Scholarships in this category will be awarded to students who are current participants in East Point/College Park Alumnae Delta Academy, Delta GEMS, or EMBODI. Applicants in all scholarship categories must meet the minimum cumulative GPA requirement (2.5 on a 4.0 scale).

We solicit your support by asking you to copy and distribute the scholarship application to interested African-American male and female high school seniors. Students may also receive a copy of the application directly from our website <https://epcpdst.org/epcp-scholarship-program/> or by sending a request via email to scholarships@epcpdst.org.

Applicants should provide a completed application packet, which includes: an application, official school transcript, counselor verification, Disbursement of Scholarship Funds Agreement and two letters of recommendation. The completed packet **MUST** be postmarked no later than **March 1st**. Mail application packets to:
