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## Program Details

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### Important Features:

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- Sessions are to be attended two days a week, for 1 hour and 30 minutes. The last five minutes of each session will be used for a brief consultation with parents.
- Limited space available; six students only with two Orton-Gillingham (OG) trained instructors.
- Students can join the program at any time.
- Each student is instructed *at their own level*, and *at their own pace* of learning.
- Modeled after our very successful Summer Intensive Literacy Camp.

### Billing and Termination of Contract:

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- Daily 1.5 hour session fee: \$75 (*Enjoy the savings of a \$50 hourly rate!*)
- Program commitment is on a monthly basis, with non-refundable monthly fees paid in advance, on the first business day of the month. **A valid card must be on file for billing.**
- A \$30.00 materials fee will apply at enrollment. Students advancing in the program will incur minimal workbook fees throughout the program.
- One group make-up session per month will be offered, times/dates announced monthly.
- This plan will continue until we are notified in writing with a 2-week notice of termination, or until the program director determines the student has met the goals of the program.

### 17-week Fall Class/Billing Schedule

September - 4 weeks

October - 5 weeks

November - 3 weeks (no classes the week of Thanksgiving)

December - 3 weeks (2-week holiday break)

### Important Details:

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Initial baseline assessment required and progress testing included. If an enrolling student does not have baseline data on file with TPE, an individual baseline assessment will be scheduled following program enrollment for an additional one-time fee of \$55.

Attendance is imperative to be beneficial to a student.
