

Student Scholarship Policy and Procedure

Purpose and Scope

To provide scholarship and fellowship grants to individuals in financial need, attending public/private schools (primary, secondary, university, graduate school).

Eligibility:

1. All new applicants must submit a verification letter from the village chief and pastor to verify their financial needs.
 - a. For renewing students, the village chief and pastor's letter need to be submitted when students are moving from primary to middle/middle to high/high to university
2. For university students will contribute 50\$/semester whenever that they will pay for their tuition (it is dependent on the tuition).
3. All scholarship recipients must bring report cards annually to renew their scholarship with all passing scores.
 - a. If the applicant does not have passing scores (passing all subjects), they will contribute another 50\$ beside the 50\$ above. And if they fail on their major subject they will need to contribute another 100\$ beside the 50\$.
 - i. Example: If the student studies Accounting and they have 5 subjects for semester 1. By the end of semester 1, they failed 2 subjects. So they will contribute 50\$ + another 50\$ for their next semester.
 - ii. But among the 2 subjects, they failed in Accounting subject (the major) the students need to contribute with us 100\$ + another 50\$ for their next semester.
4. Be responsible to pay back to GBGM with the exact amount that we pay for you if you quit school.
5. All students moving from primary to middle/ middle to high/ high to the university must submit an essay answering a question on their goal in life.
6. All new applicants for university must pass the high school exam and submit a high school report card along with the application.
7. We will accept 1 scholarship recipient per family. Not include cousin, niece, or nephew...etc

Scholarship Process

- The applicant submits the Scholarship Application Form including all necessary documents.
- All applicants for university will be interviewed by the Scholarship committee.
- Scholarship Committee will review the application (and interviews) and will notify the applicant of their decision.

When to apply?

For students who are applying for a scholarship, please fill out a scholarship application for each academic year, and apply to the UMC office from July to December.
