MEMORY VERSE IS  
JOHN 13:34-35:**

“A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.”  
 John 13:34-35

**Work on committing this verse to memory and thinking about it this week.**

***How is the way that Jesus loves different than the way the world defines “love”? What is one specific way you can show someone the love of Jesus through your actions this week?***

**REVIEW TODAY'S MESSAGE BY DISCUSSING THESE QUESTIONS AS A FAMILY:**

1. Read John 13:31-35 together as a family. Retell the events of this passage in your own words. Where is this taking place? What is Jesus saying about Himself? How should we respond to what Jesus is saying?
2. Jesus references this command as a “new” commandment? What makes it “new”? How does loving others as Jesus loves us, look differently than even obeying the command to “love your neighbor as yourself”?
3. How does loving like Jesus, glorify (show the specialness and worth of ) Jesus/God? What is the relationship between loving like Jesus and worshipping Jesus? Read Romans 12:1 for a hint and then read all of Romans 12 together for some ideas on tangible ways to show the love of Jesus. Which of the commands in this chapter is hardest for you to obey, which is easiest?
4. In this passage, Jesus tells His disciples that He is living and they cannot come with Him, at least not yet. Why is it important for us to show the love of Jesus on earth in these days when Jesus is now in Heaven?
