**REVIEW TODAY'S MESSAGE BY DISCUSSING THESE QUESTIONS AS A FAMILY:**

1. Read John 17 together as a family. Rewrite this prayer down with your family or on your own using your own words to help you gain a better understanding of what Jesus is saying. Think back through all of what Jesus has been telling His disciples in John 13-16—how is this prayer encouraging for us to carry out what Jesus has said in earlier chapters?
2. Unity is a key theme in this prayer of Jesus'. Why do you think Jesus cares so much about unity among His people? How does unity help to glorify (show the value and worth) of God? What are some practical ways your family can encourage unity with other believers this week? How does unity within the church lead to glory for believers?
3. In verse 17, Jesus asks that His people be sanctified (transformed to be more like Jesus) in the truth and comments that “Your Word is Truth”. In what ways is the Bible important for us to grow in Christ-likeness? How is this prayer request of Jesus encouraging to you even when you don't fully understand some things in the Bible? Do you spend regular time in God's Word? If you do, how have you seen yourself grow to be more like Jesus because of this? If you don't, why not?  
How can your family help you to spend more time studying the Truth of Scripture?
