MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES:

FULL MEMBER

Dues: \$60 per year

Full Members have completed at least fifty (50) hours of Jungian Analysis or Jungian-oriented therapy, attested to in writing by the applicant's analyst or therapist. Full Members may vote in APC Executive Committee elections, may sit on the Executive Committee and/or on Board Committees, and may become a member of the KML Board of Trustees if a vacancy arises. Active members of 15 years' standing may retain active status even if they no longer live in or near NYC.

ASSOCIATE MEMBER

Dues: \$30 per year

Associate Members have completed at least fifty (50) hours of Jungian Analysis or Jungian-oriented therapy, attested to in writing by the applicant's analyst or therapist. They live 50 miles or more away from NYC and cannot attend meetings regularly and shall have no vote.

STUDENT MEMBER

Dues: \$30 per year

Student Members are full-time college students who are interested in learning about C.G. Jung and participating in the activities sponsored by the APC.

Student Members will receive an orientation into the theories of Dr. Jung, the policies and principles of the APC and the Kristine Mann Library and the C.G. Jung Building.

Student Members must provide a copy of their valid Student ID when registering at this level.
