**CALL TO ORDER –**

A comment was made by one of our members that there should be more male oriented quilts as well as wheelchair quilts.

Treasurer – Judy Hively announced that the budget for the new fiscal year (June 2019-May 2020) was approved yesterday by the board. A motion to approve the budget was made by Allison Bailey, seconded by Tricia Steinfeld and the membership agreed.

Speaker Hospitality – Maribeth Benedict announced that she is collecting name for members interested in hosting a speaker.

Patrice Lambourne – Informed the guild that the Ventura Modern Quilt Guild is offering a class by Jean Emby on July 7<sup>th</sup> at the Marriott in Ventura. The fee is \$75.00 and registration can be done on their website.

Linda Stone – Explained that the Red & White quilts for our upcoming quilt show need to be at our July meeting to be photographed & voted on. The reds can be tone on tone but read red, the whites likewise can be tone on tone but read white. They can be any shape but have a total perimeter of 72” – 100”.

Workshops – Andrea Ramirez announced that Lorraine Tennyson’s workshop tomorrow will be for log cabin blocks. July workshop is Wondering Geese by Sylvia Davis. She announced that the non- member fee for classes will be reduced to an additional \$15.00 more.
