- There will be separate tables for each category


### **For this event PLEASE DO NOT:**




## CQA IS INVITING YOU!

# BLOCK OF THE MONTH

We are now on to our second and third BOM. I'm learning to use Electric Quilt, so hopefully the patterns will now be easier to print, with darker lines and the 1/4" outside line already drawn. Your finished block, once completed and trimmed to the outside seam allowance, should measure 7-1/2".



“Up the Stairs” is the July BOM. It’s one of the easiest variations of a log cabin block to sew. You can fussy cut the center square, as in the sample. Or, maybe try to create an optical illusion of stairs by using just two colorways. This block is also known as “Courthouse Steps”.



The August BOM is called “Flowers in the House”. I combined a larger center square with a pieced flower, surrounded by log cabin strips. This pattern has some angles, but with the techniques of foundation paper piecing you’ll be fine!

Our July and August BOM will be posted on the CQA website around the first day of each month. You’ll also receive an email notifying you when the patterns are posted and ready for printing.


