Megan Minter's concern was with morning drop-off. She was hoping cars could be organized better in the line to prevent any accidents.

Principal's Report: New art teacher started on September 21. Ms. Piszczek is impressed with the children keeping their masks on and she said students are excited to be back in school. Jill Phillips asked about how children's temperature is taken in the morning. Ms. Piszczek said that the nurse is following CDC guidelines.
