SCA Virtual Meeting Minutes via Zoom  
February 4, 2020

Meeting was held virtually with the flag salute at 9:45am.

**Approval of Minutes:** There was not a January 2020 meeting due to there being no new business to discuss. December 3<sup>rd</sup> minutes were approved by Louise VanBrunt and seconded by Darlene Arnot.

- **Treasurer's Report:** Beginning balance \$7,874.03 and ending balance is \$7279.03.

**Principal's Report:**

- Dr. Anderson was not present at the meeting today.

**Old/On going Business:**

- SCA storage closet..ESCA items were moved from the storage closet to their trailer outside VTHS. Food items were all donated to the SCAs, so as to not put items outside. Pam McCann and Alison moved all the items
- The ESCA is in need of donations for a silent Tricky Tray auction. They are doing it from Walnut Ridge. A silent auction company will be hosting it. The ESCA needs assistance putting baskets together. The ESCA meeting is tomorrow. All donations can be dropped off at Walnut Ridge. Since there are no students there, they borrowed a room to put all donation items in. All SCAs can work on them there, separately or together.
- Our Gambling registration has not been received yet. The check has yet to be cashed from December 2020. Without the registration, it poses a problem for our March bingo.
- Bingo is scheduled for the 5<sup>th</sup> of March. We have the space approved, we just need the state and town approval.
- As of Friday Feb 5<sup>th</sup> all indoor gatherings have been expanded by the state to 35% but no greater than 150 individuals.
- We will set up a separate meeting, once our registration is approved, to discuss possibly taking a list of guests to stay within the approved headcount, serving food and prepacked snacks...etc...

**New business:**

- The Student Life Committee is trying to do something special for the students of VTHS on March 13<sup>th</sup>. They are hosting a carnival. They hosted a meeting with 2 students from each grade providing their input.
- Justine VanBlarcom has questions regarding who is funding the event. The committee is also looking for funding for matching t-shirts for the event.
- It is being hosted on the 1year anniversary of the VTSD shut down.
- SCADT (Senior Citizen Appreciation Dinner Theater) – In the past approx.. 175 senior citizens would come to VTHS for dinner and a show. Since that cannot happen this year, 400 senior citizens will receive a package of a terra cotta planter, filled with seeds, soil, artwork by the students of the district and cookies. Dayna Germinario is coordinating the artwork portion of the package. Justine had questions regarding distribution of the packages to 400 seniors.
- All can be answered at the ESCA meeting tomorrow at 3pm. The ESCA is asking for approximately \$82 from each SCA to supplement the remainder of the cost after donations have been factored in.
- Next SCA meeting date is 3/4/21, then 4/1, 5/6, and 6/3
