## Cedar Point Sends Trains to National Roller Coaster Museum

Cedar Point in Sandusky, Ohio, one of America's oldest amusement parks, recently made two important contributions to the National Roller Coaster Museum (NRCMA). The park shipped ride vehicles to NRCMA's archive facility in Plainview, Texas: "Wildcat," an Anton Schwarzkopf coaster taken down in 2011, and "Disaster Transport," an indoor coaster removed in 2012 to make room for the park's newest coaster, "GateKeeper."
