## Savigny-les-Beaune



### Savigny-les-Beaune Rouge 2017

*A more elegant and more expressive nose derives more from the red side of the fruit spectrum along with pretty spice and soft earth wisps. The supple, forward and easy-going flavors, like the rest of the range, are barely medium weight in density while delivering enough depth and length on the mildly rustic and warm finale to be interesting.*

### Savigny-les-Beaune 1er Cru “Les Peuillets” 2017

*A brooding nose of poached plum displays pretty spice and floral nuances. The supple and nicely energetic middle weight flavors aren't especially dense, but they do possess the intrinsic refinement of a classic Peuillets, all wrapped in a dusty and lingering finish.*

### Savigny-les-Beaune 1er Cru “La Dominode” 2017

*Initially there is a whiff of reduction that relatively quickly blows off to reveal a similar if slightly more elegant nose where the spice elements are just a bit more prominent. The delicious if lighter weight flavors exude a lovely minerality while delivering good length if limited depth.*
