### GROWING REGION:

Cramant, Champagne, France

**Marne Valley:** Meunier

**Côtes des Blancs:** Chardonnay

**Côteaux Sud d'Épernay :** Pinot Noir

### TERROIR:

From 40 parcels with an average age of 50 years.  
An accord between 3 grapes and 3 terroirs.

### GRAPES:

Pinot Meunier (70%), Chardonnay (20%), Pinot Noir (10%).

### VINIFICATION NOTES:

Bottled in March after the harvest and aged for five years on the lees before disgorgement.  
Dosage is 5 grams.

### TASTING NOTES:

Pure and full-bodied with a generous core of red fruit. Rich with a lingering finish.

### GROWING REGION:

Cramant, Champagne, France

**Côteaux Sud d'Épernay :** Monthelon, Mancy-  
**Côtes des Blancs:** Avize, Cramant, Chouilly,  
Cuis

### TERROIR:

From vines averaging 40 years of age.

### GRAPES:

Chardonnay.

### VINIFICATION NOTES:

Aged on its lees for 30 months in steel or glass-lined concrete tanks before disgorgement. Dosage is 7 grams.

### TASTING NOTES:

The perfect aperitif wine. Fresh, lifted, chalky and full of white and yellow orchard fruits.
