


Masonry Fireplace Components/ Maintenance



Fireplace / Chimney Maintenance

- **A.** We recommend that you have your fireplace cleaned, and your chimney swept and inspected annually if you use your fireplace on a regular bass.
- **B.** If you do not use your fireplace regularly, you should have your fireplace and chimney inspected prior to using it for the first time each season.

Hearth: is the floor of the firebox.
Ash Box is an area under the firebox to store hot ashes.
Hearth Extension: The minimum general hearth extension size is 16 inches.

<u>Damper</u> closes off the flue when not in use, to prevent heat loss. This is required to be locked in the

open position when a gas log appliance is

Throat / Breast: The throat is the opening in which the smoke travels from the firebox into the flue.

And the breast is the front side of the throat.

<u>Lintel</u>: is the metal beam used to hold up the brick or rock over the firebox opening.
