Procedure for Selection of Delegates/Alternates to Republican State Convention District 10

- 1. The selection of delegates to the Republican State Convention shall occur immediately upon completion of the organizational meeting of the District Committee following the primary election in the years in which a State Convention occurs.
- 2. The newly elected District Chairperson shall conduct the selection procedure.
- 3. The District Officers (Chairman, Vice Chairman and Secretary) shall be selected in recognition of their service to the District. They will be polled to determine if they are willing and able to attend the convention. In the event one or more of them is unable to serve as a delegate, that delegate position(s) and alternates will be filled per step 4.
- 4. Precinct chairpersons and others interested in being selected will be allowed to self-nominate for the positions of delegate or alternate. Precinct chairpersons who have attended a minimum of 6 of the preceding 12 meetings will be placed in Pool A. The remaining nominees will be placed in Pool B. All nominees will be assigned a number and the numbers placed in either Pool A or B. The numbers will be randomly drawn from containers for Pool A and Pool B. The order in which the numbers are drawn will determine the order in which the delegates/alternates will be selected. If there are open delegate positions remaining after Step 3, those positions will be filled by the first name(s) drawn. Once the delegate positions are filled, the remaining names will be selected as alternates in the order in which they were drawn.
- 5. The chair will entertain a motion to officially elect the selected slate of delegates and alternates to represent the District at the State Convention.
- 6. All persons not selected as a delegate are eligible to participate in the delegate/alternate procedure of the Central Committee.
