

Alternate Procedure for election of delegates and alternates for Legislative District 35.

Per Article I, Section 1 (b), Idaho Republican Party Rules

- (1) The newly elected Legislative District Chair shall conduct the election of delegates and alternate delegates to the state convention.*
- (2) Precinct committeeman elected at the last primary election shall place names in nomination as delegates to the convention. Nominations will remain open until all who wish to do so have had an opportunity to nominate a delegate.*
- (3) Precinct committeemen will vote for three (3) delegates for state convention by secret ballot.*
- (4) Two or more people shall be appointed by the Chair to count the ballots and report the results to the Chair.*
- (5) In the event of a tie, the Legislative District Chair shall cast the deciding vote.*
- (6) The same procedure shall then be applied to electing three (3) alternates to state convention. Alternates will be designated by the number of votes received as first alternate, 2nd alternate, and 3rd alternate.*
- (7) A nominee for both delegate and alternate shall have given prior permission to have his/her name placed in nomination and shall pledge his intention to attend the convention.*
