- **EAC Meeting Summary Approval**

- The meeting summary of the September 2019 meeting was read and approved.

- Ms. Heisey announced:

- Jim Morrisson – Trolley Track Exhibition
 - Mr. Morrisson reviewed the overall history of the Toonerville Trolley Line. Notes were sent to the EAC prior to the meeting. He mentioned that 3 trees need to be removed to support the tracks installation. It was unclear what was being requested of the EAC. Safety and environmental concerns were discussed. It was recommended to move the tracks further away from the road for safety reasons and PADOT right away. The EAC voted and agreed to postpone the review until the next EAC meeting due to inconsistencies in the plan. Details of the plan will be provided prior to the meeting from the BOS and Historical commission.

- **EAC 2019**

- Regional National Solar Tour held on Saturday, October 19th.
 - Mr. Meyers attended the tour which consisted of 36 locations.
- Burning yard waste, exception clarifications
