curs. Even so, you can keep them in the garage or other warm area until the warm temperatures rebound, usually in a day or two. Divide and transplant herbaceous perennials that bloom in late summer or fall. Fertilize all of the garden plants now. Fertilized amaryllis usually produced better blooms in April.

What's Blooming?

This time of year floral colors will strike a nice pose against cobalt blue sky. Watch for extraordinary blooms from bulbs, shrubs and trees. Fine examples come from amaryllis, bougainvillea, Indian hawthorn, red powder-puff, star jasmine, yellow allamanda, Tabebuias, red silk cotton, orchid trees, vera wood, and Texas geiger.
