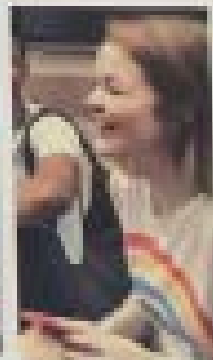

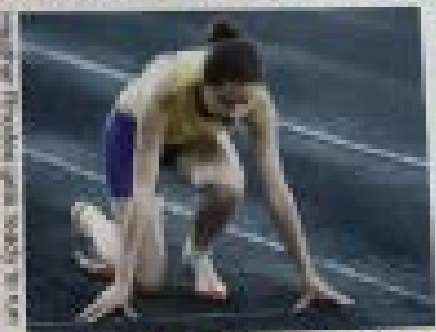
Gavin Nash, senior captain of the basketball team

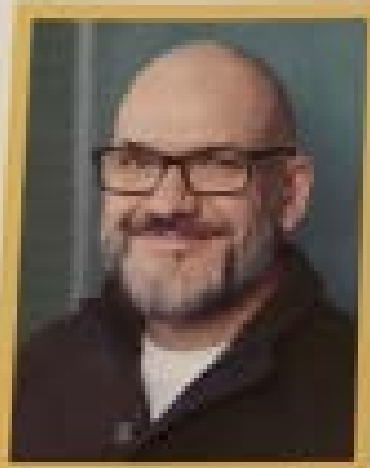

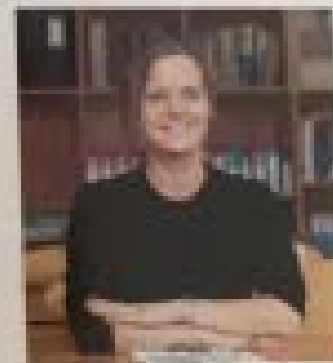
