Pastor's Corner

I should like to suggest another word to you, not as a substitute for the word "sin," but as a useful clue in the interpretation of the word "sin": "separation." Separation is an aspect of the experience of everyone. Perhaps the word "sin" has the same root as the word "asunder." In any case, *sin is separation*. And separation is threefold: there is separation among individual lives, separation of [people] from [themselves], and separation of all [people] from the God. This three-fold separation constitutes the state of everything that exists; it is a universal fact; it is the fate of every life. And it is our human fate in a very special sense. For we as [people] know that we are separated. We not only suffer with all creatures because of the self-destructive consequences of our separation, but also know *why* we suffer. We know that we are estranged from something to which we really belong, and with which we *should* be united. ... Before sin is an act, it is a state. —Paul Tillich, "You Are Accepted,"
