

Paragraph Writing Rules:

Good paragraph should have a good beginning and a satisfying conclusion. The sentences in the paragraph should be logically connected with one another.

The length of the paragraph should always be taken into account when writing on any given topic. If the student is asked to write in hundred words only he should aim at brevity and condensation of thought. He should avoid giving examples or illustrations and mainly concentrate on the exposition of ideas. However there is no prescribed limit, he can afford to reinforce his ideas with examples, quotations, etc, etc. But even then the length of a paragraph should not be allowed to exceed 200 words.

A paragraph must have a unity of tone and coherence of thought. If it is a narrative paragraph the events should be narrated in a proper sequence. If you are asked to write a description it should be brief. Repetition of Ideas should be avoided at all costs.
