**Structure:**

**Subject + 1<sup>st</sup> form of verb + object**

**Rule 1:**

If subject come as He, she, it, name \_\_\_\_\_ will use **s, es** with 1<sup>st</sup> form of verb.

**Example:**

1. He writes a story.
2. Sara reads newspaper.
3. She washes clothes.
4. It rains.

**Rule 2:**

If subject come as I, we, you, they \_\_\_\_\_ will not use **s, es** with the 1<sup>st</sup> form of verb.

**Examples:**

1. I write a story.
2. We wash clothes.
3. They drive a car.
