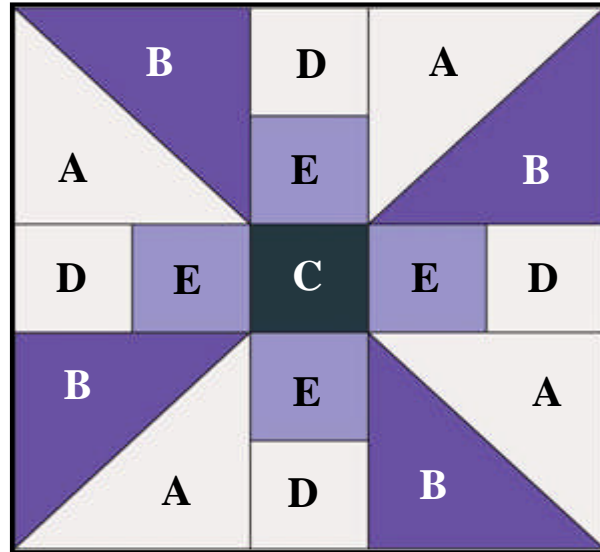

Pilgrim Wheel



NOTE: Choose your own muted 17th Century "Pilgrim" colors.

From light neutral cream print:

- 2 5-7/8" squares (A)
- 4 3" squares (D)

From dark 'Pilgrim' print:

- 2 5-7/8" squares (B)

From light 'Pilgrim' print:

- 4 3" squares (E)

From darkest 'Pilgrim' print (NOT black)

- 1 3" squares (C)



Construction:

- > Draw line diagonally on the back of each 5-7/8" square.
- > Pair each (A) square with a (B) square, and with right sides together, sew 1/4" on each side of each diagonal line. Cut on the diagonal line. Open half-square triangle (HST) blocks and press toward the dark side.
- > Sew center horizontal strip D-E-C-E-D as above.
- > Sew top vertical unit D-E. Press.
- > Sew bottom vertical unit E-D. Press.
- > Assemble top A/B-D/E-A/B units.
- > Assemble bottom B/A-E/D-B/A unit.
- > Sew top row to Center, and Center to bottom row as shown above. Block will measure 13" square.
- > Trim 1/4" from EACH side of the square by placing the 1" line of your 6" x 24" ruler along seam "X" (shown above.) The next 5" of the ruler should cover the block and exactly 1/4" will be exposed to the right of the ruler. Trim it off. Turn your work 180 degrees and repeat the last procedure, then do the other 2 sides.
