## SAFE TECHNOLOGY & DIGITAL CITIZENSHIP

In 2015, the Safe Technology Utilization and Digital Citizenship in Public Schools (HB213) was passed into law. This bill requires charter school governing boards or school community councils to fulfill certain duties related to safe technology utilization and digital citizenship. Utah is out ahead on this issue; there are few established curriculums and programs on digital citizenship. Digital Respons-Ability has prepared curriculum and programming on this subject. We utilize a holistic approach that covers information and media literacy, digital laws, digital footprint, privacy and more. We work to empower parents and students on positive uses of technology.

## DIGITAL RESPONS-ABILITY PROGRAMS

Our program is offered to schools to meet the requirements of HB213 and educate their parents on digital citizenship and technology.

- Explain issues surrounding regarding digital access and inclusion.
- Lead a discussion where the group will collectively identify a digital citizenship issue and brainstorm ideas to address that need or opportunity.
