



## Vaccination Information for Seniors

### [City of Detroit Department of Health](#)

Detroit residents may begin scheduling appointments at the TCF Center.

#### **How to schedule:**

The following groups can schedule an appointment by calling **313-230-0505** Monday-Friday from 9 am until 6 pm:

#### **Eligible groups:**

- NEW! Any resident of the City of Detroit who is age 50 or older with a Chronic Condition(that means anyone born in 1970 or earlier)
- NEW! Manufacturing employees, provided they live or work in Detroit. Employees should check with their employer first to determine whether their company vaccinations will be done at TCF or on site. Employees at FCA/Stellantis plants (Jefferson North and Mack) will be offered vaccinations on site.
- A Good Neighbor who is age 55 or older who lives in Detroit or in Michigan, who drives a Detroit age 60+ to the TCF Center vaccine site. The appointments must be made at the same time. Detroit residents may begin scheduling appointments at the TCF Center.
- Any resident of the City of Detroit who is age 60 or older
- A Good Neighbor who is age 55 or older who lives in Detroit or in Michigan, who drives a Detroit age 60+ to the TCF Center vaccine site. The appointments must be made at the same time. Detroit residents may begin scheduling appointments at the TCF Center.
- Childcare providers and K-12 school employees.
- Adult Foster Care caregivers.
- U.S. Post Office employees who live or work in Detroit.
- Employees of the City of Detroit or city-related agencies who are working from their regular job site. (Employees working from home are not eligible at this time).
- Federal, state law enforcement officials who live or work in Detroit and report to a job site, such as FBI, ATF, DEA, U.S. Marshall, U.S. Attorney, State Police, and MiCity Michigan Attorney General.

- Active members of the clergy who live or work in Detroit and whose ministry brings them into face-to-face contact with congregation members. Bring ministry ID with you to appointment.
- Funeral home/mortuary services employees who live or work in Detroit. Bring pay stub/ funeral home ID with you to appointment.
- All food or beverage workers living or working in the City of Detroit: Grocery stores, restaurants, meat packing, food and beverage handling facilities.
- Security guards and janitors.
- All identified populations in Group 1A. Paid and unpaid persons in health care settings who have the potential for direct or indirect exposure to patients or infectious materials working in Detroit.
- Detroit residents 18+ with intellectual and developmental disabilities, caregivers of those residents and home healthcare providers if they travel in the same vehicle during the appointment. One live-in caregiver per resident. Evidence of condition required at appointment.
- Any resident of the City of Detroit who is 60 or older with chronic illness. Conditions include: cancer (current/in-remission), chronic kidney disease, COPD, asthma, pulmonary fibrosis, cystic fibrosis, heart conditions, coronary artery disease, cardiomyopathy, hypertension, HIV, severe obesity, sickle cell disease, type 1 or 2 diabetes, liver disease, cerebrovascular disease, Alzheimer's disease, dementia.

**\*There will be no cost to individuals for the COVID-19 vaccination.\***

### **What do you need to make a reservation?**

If you are in one of the identified groups to receive a vaccine, one caller can book for multiple people in your car. You will need 6 pieces of information for each person when you make the call:

1. **Name**
2. **Address**
3. **Date of Birth**
4. **Phone number**
5. **Email**
6. **Have you had previous allergic reactions to vaccines?**

### **Senior Saturdays - COVID-19 Vaccines**

COVID-19 Vaccines are available BY APPOINTMENT ONLY for Detroiters 60+ at more locations in the Detroit community.

**New!** Any area resident age 55+ can be vaccinated at a Senior Saturday location if they schedule an appointment with a Detroit resident age 60+ and drive them to their appointment.

## **Meijer**

Meijer vaccine clinics **are not open to walk-ups**. Participants must be registered through the retailer's online system in order to be scheduled for a vaccine. There are 3 ways to register for a vaccine appointment.

## **Rite Aid**

- \*Rite Aid is currently prioritizing vaccinating groups listed in green

Individuals will not be charged for the vaccine or its administration. The federal government will pay for the cost of the vaccine.

## **Beaumont Hospital**

We recognize there are many people eagerly awaiting their turn to get vaccinated. Right now, we still have approximately 150,000 eligible patients in the 65+ category who have not yet received an invitation to schedule a vaccination.

At this time, our teams are having thoughtful, robust discussions about how to incorporate the newly released expanded guidelines into our vaccine process. We will be sharing additional details and information soon.

Beaumont is currently using a randomized process to invite patients age 65 and older and those 50 and older with an underlying health condition to schedule their COVID-19 vaccine appointment as doses become available. You must have a myBeaumontChart in order to receive an invitation. Please continue to monitor your email for an invitation. All vaccination appointments must be scheduled in advance online. Walk-ins are not permitted.

HAVE AN ACTIVE *myBeaumontChart* ACCOUNT?

If you are 65 or older and already have an active personal *myBeaumontChart* account:

1. Login to your [myBeaumontChart account](#) and confirm your current email address is listed on your account.
2. Watch your personal email inbox for a message from Beaumont. Our computer system is using a randomized process to select patients who meet the criteria. At this time, a limited number of appointments are available so [you may not receive an invitation right away](#).
3. Once you receive an email, it will include a link that allows you to schedule your appointment. You cannot schedule until you receive that invitation.

### **Henry Ford Health Systems**

- In accordance with current state guidelines, we are prioritizing vaccines for patients by age and certain high-risk conditions.
- If you are an established Henry Ford patient, we will contact you by text, email or phone when you become eligible to receive a vaccine and as appointments become available. We will reach out to you based on the contact information you have provided to us to let you know when you can schedule a vaccine appointment.
- When we contact you to let you know it's your turn, this notification is only for you and cannot be transferred to anyone else, including your caregiver, family members or friends.
- When it's your turn to get the vaccine, and you receive your notification, you can schedule your appointment in MyChart. You will be shown locations, dates and times where vaccines are offered, so you can select the an appointment slot that is most convenient for you.

- Appointments fill up quickly, so it's important to schedule your appointment as soon as we contact you. If there are no appointments available, check back as we add new appointments often.
- If you are a Henry Ford patient and do not have an existing MyChart account, we encourage you to sign up for an account to streamline the scheduling and notification process.
- You cannot schedule a COVID-19 vaccine by calling our contact center. You also cannot schedule a COVID-19 vaccine through your regular Henry Ford doctor at your medical center. You may need to drive some distance to the vaccination site that has an available appointment.
