

Clubhouse Services Re-opening Agreement

In accordance with guidelines set forth by local and state government and health officials, Community Brain Injury Services Clubhouse programs will re-open for services on **Wednesday, July 15th**.

Community Brain Injury Services will follow the protocol listed below for re-opening the Clubhouses. This document includes measures the programs will be taking to protect your health, as well as protocol we will ask all individuals entering our programs and offices to follow.

This health and safety protocol will continue until further notice.



Occupancy- Clubhouses will have no more than 50% occupancy, or ***no more than 15 individuals***, in the program at a time



Social distancing- All individuals will be asked to follow social distancing guidelines, which includes maintaining at least ***6 feet of space between themselves and anyone else at all times***



Masks- Every person entering a CBIS program or office will have to ***wear a mask the entire time they are in the building.*** If you don't have a mask, one will be provided



Hand washing- All individuals are asked to ***wash their hands for at least 20 seconds with warm water and soap*** after:

- Using the restroom
- Coughing or sneezing
- Eating
- Touching common surfaces
- Touching your face
- Removing masks or gloves

Handwashing protocol will be prominently displayed at each CBIS program and hand sanitizer will also be available



Health screening- Every person entering the program will have their temperature checked and will be asked a series of health screening questions recommended by the CDC prior to entering the building every day. ***If you have a temperature of 99.5 or above or have any symptoms that may indicate illness, you will be asked to return home with guidance on when you can return to the program***



Community Outings- In an effort to minimize exposure risk, ***all community outings are temporarily suspended.*** This includes supply trips, social programs, and individual outings during lunch
