Herb & Fiber Festival: June 6 – 7 Saturday from 10am – 5pm & Sunday from 10am – 3pm This marks the 36th year for this signature festival that draws hundreds of people looking to start their gardens and get closer to nature. There will be hanging baskets, bedding flats, perennials, annuals, garden artists and herbs. Join us Saturday for our annual “Soup at the Sawmill” luncheon. Starting at 11:30, you receive a handmade pottery soup bowl (which is yours to keep), homemade soup, bread, dessert and a drink for \$12.

Woodcarvers Festival: July 11 - 12 10am – 5pm This festival has featured carefully hand-carved creations. These impressive works of art are displayed throughout the weekend and many are available for purchase. Carving competitions, exhibitions, demonstration, classes, and vendors round out the event.

Chainsaw Carvers Festival: September 18 – 20 10am – 5pm Auctions on Saturday at 4 pm and Sunday at 3:30 pm. Come see carvers in action as they create beautiful works of art from a simple log. Stay for the auctions to bid on and purchase some of these beautiful pieces!

Vintage & Antique Market: October 10 10am – 5pm A new indoor/outdoor flea market showcasing antique and repurposed goods including jewelry, home décor, furnishings, tools, paints, parts and pieces. Our Creative Classrooms will host experts sharing their know-how, tips and tricks to tackle your own.

Gingerbread Tour: November 6 – 8 Friday & Saturday 10am to 5 pm & Sunday 10 am to 4 pm Part of the annual Gingerbread Tour from Cook Forest to Historic Brookville, shop our bountiful craft market where more than 50 local artisans display their hand-crafted items.
