The 2020 Cook Forest Chainsaw Carvers' Round-up will be held September 18 – 20, 2020 from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm daily with a Saturday auction at 4:00 pm and Sunday auction at 3:30 pm. Carvers are required to set up by Friday morning September 18 at 10 am. This is our largest event of the season, so we invite chainsaw artists to fill out an application for a space at the event. - ✓ Items for display and sale must be of high quality, demonstrating excellence of craftsmanship. You understand you may be required to remove any work that is deemed inappropriate or in poor taste.
- ✓ You confirm that you understand the Cook Forest Sawmill Center for the Arts is not responsible for accidents that may result in damage. Each Carver will provide a copy of a Certificate of Liability Insurance
- ✓ You agree to demonstrate your artistry and maintain your display during the advertised event hours to clean your space and disposing of personal trash at the conclusion. DCNR will clean up all wood debris.
- ✓ You will have carved pieces for sale directly to the public.
- ✓ You will provide a minimum of two (2) carved pieces for each of the auctions on Saturday and Sunday with the proceeds from the auctions split 50/50 with the carver and Cook Forest Sawmill Center for the Arts.
- ✓ The Cook Forest Sawmill Center for Arts in partnership with DCNR will provide equipment to move the logs for the carvers.
- ✓ All logs will be provided to carvers.
- ✓ A limited number of cabins/campsites will be available for out of town carvers call or email for availability.
- ✓ Carvers will be able to set and start carving as soon as Wednesday September 16, 2020.
