Dear Residents, Families, and Friends:

Our Lancashire facility has suspended visitation due to a positive COVID test result. All other facilities are open for visitation. Visitation is an extremely important activity and we ask that everyone continues to follow the steps below to maintain the highest levels of safety.

- Continue to bring your COVID-19 vaccination record to the facility.
- Visitors need to complete the screening log to ensure you are not having symptoms.
- Unvaccinated individuals need to wear a mask while visiting. Visitation will take place in an area designated by each facility.
- Visitation requires an appointment. The scheduling link is located on the top center of the homepage of our website, www.vaahs.com. You can also call the facility at the numbers listed below to schedule an appointment.
