MISSION

The National Association for the Education of Homeless Children and Youth (NAEH CY) is a national nonprofit, membership association. Our mission is dedicated to ensuring educational equity and excellence for children and youth experiencing homelessness, including high mobility children and youth, through collaboration, learning, leadership and capacity building of our members.

Our members serve the approximately 1.5 million children and youth experiencing homelessness.

VISION

Our vision is to ensure that every child and youth experiencing homelessness is successful in school, from early childhood through higher education.

CONFERENCE

The conference is the only national conference of its kind geared towards providing professional development to those servicing our children and youth in public schools and charter schools throughout the nation. The annual conference, first started in the late 80s, brings together those who serve our children and youth experiencing homelessness across the nation.

PAST ATTENDANCE

IN-PERSON 1,700+; VIRTUAL 2,200+

Last year's conference was held virtually, registering approximately 2,200 attendees from 50 states, D.C., Guam, and Puerto Rico. In 2019, in our most recent entirely in-person conference held in Washington, D.C., we registered approximately 1,700 attendees from 48 states, D.C., Guam, and Puerto Rico.

This year our annual conference is hybrid (in-person and virtual) due to the continuous impact of COVID-19 on our health and travel. For the 2021 Conference in Atlanta, the current in-person capacity by CDC guidelines is 350, anticipated in-person attendance by the time of the event is 700, if not completely returned to pre-COVID numbers. Virtual attendee capacity is in excess of 2,000.

CEUS

The conference offers continuing education credits (CEUs) through the National Association for Social Workers (NASW) and has included other certifications in the recent past. In 2020, up to 30 credits were approved and made available to attendees.

PRESENTERS

In 2020, close to 100 expert educators, researchers, and advocates from across the nation, including five keynote speakers and several federal partners, gave of their time and talent to the more than 60 sessions. In 2019, more than 120 experts joined us, providing over 85 sessions.
