The Star of Hope building on Main Street continues to capture applause from all who pass by. Last week, banners incorporating historic photographs were placed on the street level in front of the windows which will be replaced this fall. Windows as large as these, and which are required to meet historic guidelines, are custom-made and once they are installed, this effort will continue to highlight the expertise of our talented construction and engineering crew.

We are fortunate to have been able to install the temporary roof on the building in time for winter's arrival. This roof will be replaced with slate tiles during the next phase of the project, but for now, it keeps the building from suffering any further water damage.

Eventually, when this historic landmark has been restored, the public will be able to go inside. However, the project is a long way from being finished.
