Meeting called to order by Selectmen Norman Beckwith at 6:00pm

Calling of the roll

David made a motion to accept the minutes as written. Norman seconded. Motion carried 2-0.

Norman and David will be attending a hearing with the County Commissioners Office regarding Tim Gora and the Blanchard Rd on July 20<sup>th</sup>.

Norman said William Nye is doing a great job of cleaning the town hall and post office

Mike Theriault Construction has been grading, using gravel and calcium on some of the Shirley Roads. David feels Mike has done a great job on the Blanchard Road.

Norman will be cutting down trees and fixing culverts around Shirley

The selectmen discussed the possibility of raising the rent for residents to use the Fire Station stalls annually.

Hutch asked if there are rules for a resident who is using the Fire Station stalls. Norman told Hutch they must fill out a form and they must carry their own insurance, so the town is not liable.

The Assessor will be here July 27<sup>th</sup> to finish the commitment and then the selectmen can set the mil rate.

Hutch asked if the meetings were being recorded with a recording device. Norman replied with a yes. Hutch wants to see more in the meeting minutes. Hutch also heard that anyone wanting to cut trees near the power lines must contact CMP because of liabilities.

Norman said at some point we should be thinking about doing a revaluation on the homes.
