October 20, 2021

Meeting called to order by Selectmen Norman Beckwith at 6:00pm

Calling of the roll

David made a motion to accept the minutes as amended. Norman seconded. Motion carried 2-0.

Norman went up to Rachel Cummings property line to see about the trees being cut down. There was a big mud hole so he will have to go back up.

Linda is still working with the American Rescue Plan Act which is the Local Fiscal Recovery Program for the state of Maine. She will have more information for the selectmen at the next meeting.

Norman said Scott Fossett with API Technology was waiting for an answer regarding the town getting an additional computer system including a monitor and docking station at the Town Office. The computer system will be used in conjunction with the Trio Software program that Geneva uses for the town taxes. Geneva will be able to get onto Trio without kicking Carolyn off the computer at the Town Office.

Norman made a motion to accept the amount to be spent on the additional computer system. David seconded. Vote carried 2-0.

Piscataquist County Economic Development Council is seeking support from Shirley for ConnectMe Broad Band Inventory/Grant in the amount of \$144.95.

Norman made a motion to accept this amount to help pay for the broad band inventory. David seconded. Motion carried 2-0.

David suggested the 3 Selectmen get together at some point to discuss the future of the Blanchard Road.

Norman made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:00pm. David seconded. Motion carried 2-0.
