DAY TEN QUESTIONS "Redemption at Last!"

1. Ruth had nothing to offer Boaz except herself; yet he still worked to redeem her. We bring nothing to Christ but our sin stained lives, yet He did all the work to redeem us.

Read Isaiah 53:3-12, 63:9, Romans 3:10-12, 3:23. According to these verses, who is righteous in God's eyes? Who does good?

2. We are all transgressors, sinners, who have broken God's law. We could not hope to redeem ourselves, but One came who could redeem us.

Read Titus 2:11-14 and Galatians 3:10-14 What did Christ redeem us from? What did He redeem us to? (Galatians 4:4-7)

3. My final question for you today is simply this: are you redeemed? Do you know that you have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God? Do you know that you are not righteous, just as no one else is? Do you know that you NEED to be redeemed? What are you waiting for? Your Kinsman Redeemer has already paid the price for you, and you have only to accept this gift of redemption and allow Him to change you from the inside out. Are you ready for that change?
