



Lesson 35 **“Ears, Mouths, Feet”**

Read 2 Thessalonians 1:7-8. When Jesus is revealed from heaven, who will He inflict vengeance on (there are two different descriptions here)?

How does Paul consider their unbelief here, as in Romans?

Read Hebrews 5:9. We receive eternal salvation when we do what?

Obedience is tied to faith in a very real way. When we stay in our unbelief, we are rebelling against our Holy God, and we *are* disobeying Him.

Read Matthew 28:18-20. What does Jesus command His disciples to do?

What are they to teach?

Does He mention anything about the type of audience that they should teach? (Size, location, etc.)

The command is simple: “Go. Make disciples. Baptize them. Teach them what you have seen and what I have commanded.” Jesus doesn’t say anything about pulpits or street corners. This command is as general as it is specific, and we need to remember that.

Read 1 Peter 3:14-16. Peter encourages the believers that their suffering for righteousness’ sake will be what?

Peter reminds them to do what in the hearts?

What are they always to be prepared for?

How should they do this?

What impact will this have on their consciences and their witness before men?

Read Psalm 19:1-5. What does David say declares God’s glory?

Where is speech and knowledge poured out?

Is there anywhere these words and knowledge have not gone?

Paul quoted this portion of Psalm 19 in Romans 10:18 to show that even David understood that God's revelation of Himself has reached the entire earth.

Read Colossians 1:5-6. Paul, here, says that the Gospel which has given hope to the people of Colossi has gone where?

What is the implication of this statement?

As you spend time with God today, thank Him for the Holy Spirit who not only enables you to know the law but to keep it. Ask Him to help you to obey and to obey in faith, not stubbornly holding on to your own agenda or wishes. Ask Him to help you to be bold in sharing the hope that you have, to understand the calling He has given to you and to be faithful to that call, in the world around you. The whole earth declares His glory; praise Him for the very heavens and earth that declare the might and glory of our Lord!
