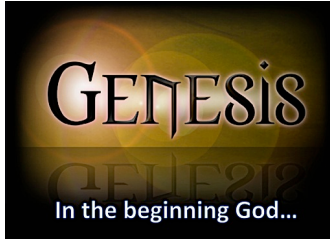


Day 5: Genesis 4-14: Details about the creation of man

The generations: *tol dot.* what is brought forth; this is what became of, used 11 times in Genesis

LORD God: Yahweh, the Self-Existent One, Israel's Redeemer; Elohim

God formed the man: *yatsar.* like a potter shaping clay; of dust, Adam means red or ground: Ps. 139:13-14; 2 Cor. 4:7

God breathed into his nostrils the breath of life: physical, mental and spiritual life: Job 33:4; Isa. 42:5; Acts. 17:24-28

God planted a garden: trees pleasant and good for food, watered by a river; gold and gems; rich with blessing
