The LORD appeared: three men, two were angels: Heb. 13:2

My Lord: Abraham offered great hospitality

Sarah will have a son next year: Sarah laughs

Is anything too hard for the LORD? Jer. 32:17; Luke 1:37; Rom. 4:16-21

The LORD revealed to Abraham: his judgment in advance: Amos 3:7

For I have chosen (*lit. known*) him: that he may command his children and household after him to keep the way of the LORD: Neh. 9:7-8a

Outcry against Sodom and Gomorrah great: their sin is very grave:
Gen. 13:13; Ezek. 16:49-50

Assignment:

Is anything impossible for God in your life? Do you trust his word more than your circumstances?

Why did God let Abraham know in advance of the judgment on Sodom and Gomorrah?

Read Matt 24, 1 Thes 5: 1-11 and 2 Peter 3:9-13. Abraham was ready and watching for travelers to help, immediately recognizing the divine nature of these three. Are you watching for opportunities to do good while waiting for the Lord? Are you ready for the Lord's return?
