- **Jacob died:** embalmed; mourned; buried with honor in Canaan
- **Joseph's brothers:** please forgive the transgression of the servant of the God of your father; fell down before him
- **Joseph wept:** forgave his brothers; understood God is judge
- **You meant evil against me:** but God meant it for good to preserve life
- **God will visit you (aid you):** bring you up out of this land: Gen 48:21; carry my bones from here: Ex. 13:19; Josh; 24:32; Heb. 11:22
