This glamorous 1920s pool house, returned to full Hollywood Regency-style splendor by [Carl D'Aquino](#) and his architect partner Francine Monaco, is not in Los Angeles. It's in Allentown, Pennsylvania, on the former estate of the family that owned Hess's, a high-end department store famed for its flamboyance and excitement. Carl's clients bought the property a few years ago and asked him to bring it back to life. The pool house, crowned with a Neptune's head, is a highlight of the restoration and partial reinvention. "I love it enough to move right in," Carl says. We do too.
