

ICS POSITIVE PANDEMIC PREVENTION **& SAFETY PROCEDURES**

April, 2021

- ICS has returned to Face-to-Face classes but offer virtual learning classes for concerned parents. This is for both Early Head Start (EHS) and Head Start classes.
- Safety measures include: temperature checks for everyone entering the centers, frequent hand washing and social distancing; masks are worn by teacher & children except during meals; visitors are restricted (central office & centers); daily cleaning of classrooms/buses and weekly in-depth cleaning.
- Learning Activities have been expanded along with ways to keep parents informed using online tools and social media.
- Parents please speak to center director for needed information and sign up for **REMIND 101** if you have not; keep phone numbers, e-mail addresses and emergency/release information updated.
- If you have to visit the center you must wear a mask, practice social distance and have your temperature checked at entry.
- Children will receive certificates of completion but no end of year ceremonies.
