

A Regular Meeting of the Bedford Township Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, January 19, 2021 located at the Bedford Township Municipal Building 1007 Shed Road with the following members present:
Supervisors: Chairman, Gregory L. Crist, Vice Chairman, Dean Shuller, Supervisor Ricky P Fetter.

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by V/Chairman Shuller:

Flag Salute: V/Chairman Shuller requested all to rise and led those in attendance in the pledge of allegiance.

Foreman Report: Foreman Rodney Bartholow reported on the following: Servicing equipment and preparing for state inspection. Cold Patching areas in need and cleaning up down trees. Rodney also met on site with Ryan of GHD at Friendship Vlg Rd at the old Cannondale Bldg Currently owned by Pratt to discuss a drainage tile that Josh from Rockland wants to know who is responsible for it. Ryan did some research and found this area used to be grass and in the early 1990's the drainage pipe was installed at the time when Cannondale added an addition. There also is piping coming from the building and connecting into the drainage pipe in question. More than likely this pipe was installed by Cannondale when the addition was put in place and the grassed area was then removed and pavement placed. After discussion the Board stated they would cost share and provide paving over the inlet area or trench area not the apron area once the pipe and inlets are replaced by the current owner Rockland MFG. Supervisor Fetter made a motion for GHD to speak to Josh at Rockland and provide a correspondence to Rockland, second by V/Chairman Shuller and carried unanimously.

Comments: Steve George asked if the Township could do anything about a property on Landmark Rd that had tires and misc items piled up, George does not live in the Township but has been speaking with Hilda Way who does live there. George serves on the Airport Authority Board and stated that the Airport's property comes to the middle of Landmark Rd and asked if the Township could find out who owns the rest of Landmark Rd. Chairman Crist stated this is a private road, therefore this would be a civil matter and the Airport Authority or property owners on Landmark Rd would need to contact an abstractor or Attorney to search the origins of the title.

GHD Engineering Report: *Representative Kevin Hartman P.E, review and report to the Board: on the following submitted projects with regards to compliance with the Subdivision Land Development Ordinance.*

Sac Shop: Wolfsburg Preliminary Plan: Kevin stated they are waiting on another submission of the plan. GHD provided comments for the Road Alteration Application also and we have not received an executed Indemnification agreement. There are remaining items to be addressed, this will remain tabled. The Board gave approval for Ryan to speak with Penn Dot and the developer about paving at the intersection of Wolfsburg Rd and Rt 30 and to co-ordinate paving when SAC repaves parking area and the Township paves the small portion of Wolfsburg Rd to the guide rails.

Bedford Borough Solar Fields: Todd Springs Reservoir Plan Project#2: The Township and GHD received another digital copy of the revised plan for review, GHD will have a response later in the week. The Board suggested that Kevin mention that we would like them to use the Fairgrounds entrance and not Fairlane Drive for all work related to the Solar project.

GHD: kevin Reported on the following: Kevin spoke with Ed Bellock pertaining to the Police Barracks and stated Bellock will provide a plan by the end of the week.
