- **Appellation:** AOC Morey Saint Denis
- **Encépagement:** Chardonnay (100%)
- **Average Annual Production:** 1,100 bottles

In The Vineyard:

- **Parcel Names, Slopes, and Locations:** From .16 ha of vines in the Seuvrées and Clos Solon lieux-dits, at the bottom of the slope below the village of Morey
- **Soil Types and Compositions:** Limestone-clay
- **Vine Age, Training, and Density:** Trained in Guyot, vines were planted in 2007 and 2011
- **Average Yields:** 35-40 hl/ha
- **Average Harvest Date and Type:** Manual, late September-early October

In The Cellar:

- **Fermentation:** Spontaneous, in neutral barrel
- **Pressing:** Pneumatic
- **Time on Lees:** 12-14 months
- **Malolactic Fermentation:** Spontaneous, in neutral barrel
- **Élevage:** 12-14 months in neutral barrel
- **Press Wine:** Blended after malolactic
- **Fining and Filtration:** Unfined, unfiltered
- **Sulfur:** Applied after malolactic and before bottling

In The Glass:

There is an underlying earthiness and rusticity that makes for an intriguing expression from one of the rare white wines of the Côte de Nuits, which has only been in production in 2012.
