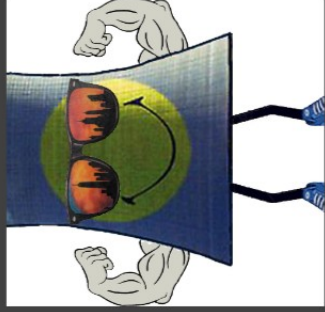

Why should you care about getting involved in this issue?
