Rena and Myer Schondorf, and their Son Ronnie 15, and Daughter Debbie 12 moved to Chomedey in 1958, when our charter was just 3 weeks old. Upon joining the Shul Myer immediately became very active. Only one year later he became a member of the Executive and since then has served on the Executive in various capacities.

He was our first cemetery Chairman and was part of the committee that negotiated the purchase of the cemetery land in Duvernay.

As Chairman of the Education Committee he organized the first Jewish Nursery Kindergarten, Hebrew School, and the Rabbi's Girl's Class. He also was involved in having the Talmud Torah take over Hebrew education in Chomedey.

He was the Shul treasurer for a year, Chairman of the Board for a year, and was House and Rentals Chairman for four years. He is now serving his second term as President.

His wife Rena has been a member of the Sisterhood and for a number of years is a volunteer worker with the Talmud Torah P.T.A., and is an advisor to them.
