"TORAH PRESENTATION CEREMONY PROGRAMME"**

12:00 Noon all cars gather in front of our Shul for 12:30 motorcade to Shomrim Laboker 6410 Westbury, in Montreal.

1:00 Presentation Ceremony by Rabbi Denberg & Cantor, Rabbi Spiro & A. Rabinovitch R. Brettschneider and Messers Skulnick, Fainer, Katz and Olshansky First Speaker: Rabbi Denberg followed by R. Brettschneider A. Rabinovitch speaks for acceptance Congregation Rises for singing of "Vahyehi Binshona" Mr. A, Zinman opens the Ark and Mr. Olshansky takes out the Torah and hands it to Messers Brettschneider, Fainer and Katz who are standing at the side of the Ark. They then pass it to Rabbi Spiro and Mr. J. Sculnick Cantor sings "Ets Chayim" as the Arc is closed Everyone leaves the Shomrim Laboker.

The Motorcade to Chomedey

Torahs are placed into opened convertible and motorcade begins with car with Torah and the cavalcade following Police cars.

Parade proceeds to Chomedey and stops in front of the Shul & High School.

The new Torah is removed from the car and students make a circle around the Torah as Messers Spector and Gurevitch bring out two other Torahs and the children dance around the torahs to Jewish music.

Entry to the Shul at 3:00 PM

Cantor sings "Vayehi" as the Ark is opened by J. Silver, doors of Ark are opened by Mr. A. Goldberg, Torahs are passed to Messers I. Segal, S. Leibovitch, R. Leibovitch, M. Shondorf and A. Wineck.

The Cantor and Congregation singing "Lacha Hashem" and "Etz Chayim" as the Torahs are placed into the Ark and the Ark is closed.

Mr. B. Kirmayer requests that everyone be seated and introduces the following speakers, Rabbi Spiro, Mr. A. Rabinovitch, Shirley Spector, and Mr. Labow,

Mincha is announced, to be followed by a reception upstairs in the Social Hall.
