MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS: This announcement is basically geared to Laval members only. Municipal elections are under way. Advance polls were open last weekend and election day(s) takes place Sat and Sun Nov 6-7. It is important that all our members go out and vote on Sunday, especially for Laval members as it indirectly affects our Synagogue.

For the past few years our municipal councillor has been Aglaia Revelakis. She has been a supporter of our shul and our community, the person to turn to when we needed answers to questions, and when we needed clarification on various issues. She always approached us when the time came, to encourage us to file early for an application for a yearly grant that is available, to ensure we filed before the fund ran out of such grants. No other political candidate in Laval, directly or indirectly has approached our community during these elections; Aglaia has. Aglaia is also a personal friend of mine (your editor), and for the 4 years while I was President, she has always been in touch with me with respect to the shul; she has been a visitor at social events and other occasions, and never refused an invitation extended to her by our shul. I am sure she will show the same courtesies and warm feelings as she deals with the new President and Executive when the time comes. While municipal councillors may run independently from mayoral candidates, Aglaia has this year affiliated herself with Sophie Trottoir, who is running for mayor in the Action Laval party. (Not to be confused with Michael Trottier, also running for mayor). When voting takes place, there are two ballots – one for municipal councillor, and one for Mayor. We encourage all Chomedey members to cast their ballots for Aglaia Revelakis for Municipal Councillor and for Sophie Trottoir as the first female Mayor of Laval.

PARSHAT HASHAVUA - WEEKLY TORAH PORTION

VAYEITZEI

Genesis 28:10-32:3

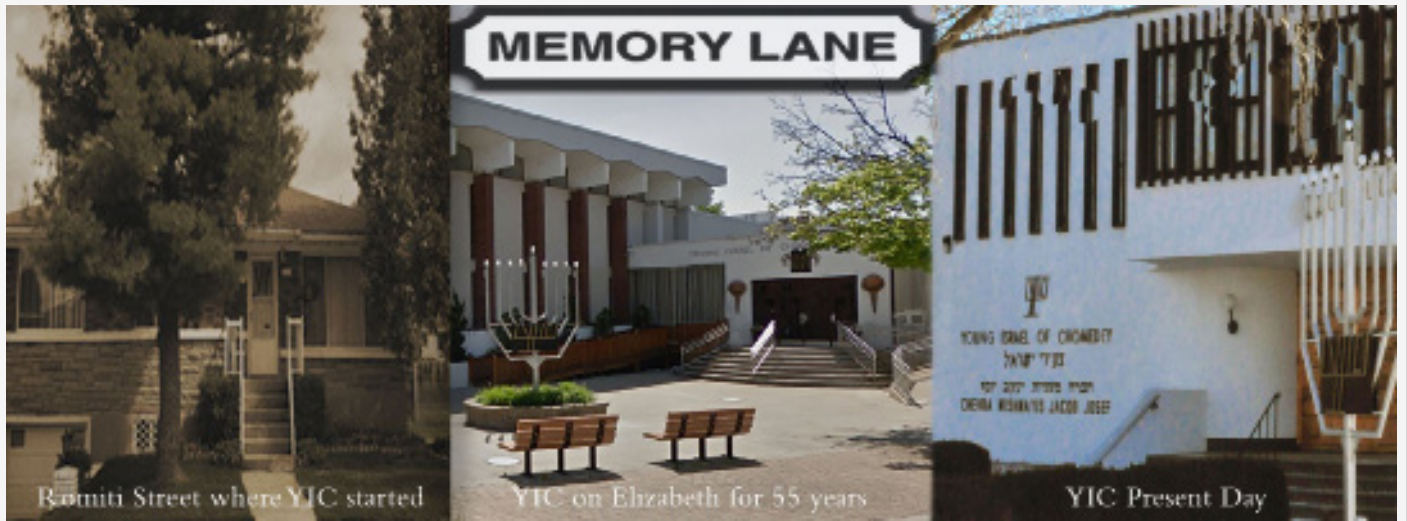


Jacob leaves his hometown of Beersheba and journeys to Charan. On the way, he encounters “the place” and sleeps there, dreaming of a ladder connecting heaven and earth, with angels climbing and descending on it; G-d appears and promises that the land upon which he lies will be given to his descendants. In the morning, Jacob raises the stone on which he laid his head as an altar and monument, pledging that it will be made the house of G-d.

In Haran, Jacob stays with and works for his uncle Laban, tending Laban’s sheep. Laban agrees to give him his younger daughter, Rachel—whom Jacob loves—in marriage, in return for seven years’ labor. But on the wedding night, Laban gives him his elder daughter, Leah, instead—a deception Jacob discovers only in the morning. Jacob marries Rachel, too, a week later, after agreeing to work another seven years for Laban.

Leah gives birth to six sons—Reuben, Simeon, Levi, Judah, Issachar and Zebulun—and a daughter, Dinah, while Rachel remains barren. Rachel gives Jacob her handmaid, Bilhah, as a wife to bear children in her stead, and two more sons, Dan and Naphtali, are born. Leah does the same with her handmaid, Zilpah, who gives birth to Gad and Asher. Finally, Rachel’s prayers are answered and she gives birth to Joseph.

Jacob has now been in Charan for fourteen years, and wishes to return home. But Laban persuades him to remain, now offering him sheep in return for his labor. Jacob prospers, despite Laban’s repeated attempts to swindle him. After six years, Jacob leaves Charan in stealth, fearing that Laban would prevent him from leaving with the family and property for which he labored. Laban pursues Jacob, but is warned by G-d in a dream not to harm him. Laban and Jacob make a pact on Mount Gal-Ed, attested to by a pile of stones, and Jacob proceeds to the Holy Land, where he is met by angels.

AN IMPORTANT NOTICE FROM RABBI BERZON

Any and all foods coming into the Shul at any time, whether it be for official meetings, or social groups, **MUST** be sealed and stamped with the seal of the kosher establishment where it was produced. Before bringing ANY food, candies, or liquor into the Shul, our Mashgiach or the Rabbi must be notified in advance. As well as all foods, only NEW and SEALED bottles of liquor and UNOPENED bags of candies may be brought in to be verified as "KOSHER" to our Rabbi's standards prior to being opened! Absolutely nothing prepared in private homes is permitted to be brought into the Shul at any time, even if they are prepared in "strictly kosher" homes. Our kitchens will remain under lock and key, and whenever any foods are to be prepared in the kitchen, it is imperative that our Mashgiach must be present to check, open and allow entry.
