ARE YOU READY FOR THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR?

2019-2020 was an unusual school year as we worked around the COVID-19 worldwide pandemic. However, the state of Maryland's immunization requirements for the 2020-2021 school year have not changed. All students are required to be compliant with immunizations whether they return to school in-person or are taught in a virtual classroom (computer).

Your child's school must have updated immunization records by the first day of school.
