More than 400 people visit Cafe Justo each year through Frontera de Cristo's border immersion ministry. Others travel to meet the families on their farms. Relationships and understanding are strengthened across borders. Cafe Justo seeks to replace an anonymous economic system with a more personal and equitable one. To make connections between coffee, faith and migration. To keep families together and on their heritage farms, and to ensure fair trade prices for the high quality organic coffee we enjoy.
