NEA-JURUPA 2021 FALL SPECIAL ELECTION

- August 30** Announcement of vacancies, Declaration of Candidacy forms, and Timeline to members via JUSD email and NEA-Jurupa website.
- September 3** Declaration of Candidacy Forms (included with election announcement and can also be found at neaj.org) and ****Candidate Statements/photo** must be received no later than 4:30 p.m. on **Sept 3** — email to sgoldberg@neaj.org.
****Each candidate may submit a candidate statement/photo of no more than one hundred (100) words regarding his/her candidacy, any words in excess of 100 will not be included. Candidate statements will be posted on the NEA-Jurupa website and emailed to members during the week of campaigning.**
- September 7** Acknowledgement of Declarations of Candidacy delivered (via email)
- September 7-13** Campaigning: Candidates may not campaign through district email or at any school sites. All campaign materials will be sent out by the election committee two times during the Week of **September 6**, and posted on the NEA-Jurupa website (neaj.org).
- September 14-20** Election via Simply Voting - You will receive an email from Simply Voting providing you with information on how to vote. If you did not receive this email in your inbox, double check your spam/junk folder. If you do not find the email, please contact the Elections Chair Michelle_Johnson@jUSD.k12.ca.us.
- September 20** The Elections Committee will download results from Simply Voting via Google Meet. The results of the election will be announced by email and posted on the NEA-Jurupa website (neaj.org) no later than **September 25** [five (5) calendar days after the counting of the ballots]. If a runoff election is necessary, this will be included in the announcement.
- October 5** A challenge to the election must be received by Michelle_Johnson@jUSD.k12.ca.us no later than 4:30 p.m. [fifteen (15) calendar days after the counting of the ballots], unless there is a runoff election.

RUNOFF ELECTION (IF NECESSARY)

- Sept. 27-Oct 1** Voting for runoff election via Simply Voting. - You will receive an email from Simply Voting providing you with information on how to vote. If you did not receive this email in your inbox, double check your spam/junk folder.
If you do not find the email, please contact the Elections Chair Michelle_Johnson@jUSD.k12.ca.us.
- October 1** The Elections Committee will download results from Simply Voting via Google Meet. The results of the election will be announced by email and posted on the NEA-Jurupa website (neaj.org) no later than **October 6** [five (5) calendar days after the counting of the ballots].
- October 16** A challenge to the election, including the runoff election, must be received by Elections Chair Michelle_Johnson@jUSD.k12.ca.us no later than 4:30 p.m. on **October 16** [fifteen (15) calendar days following the counting of the runoff ballots].
