In an effort to promote education in the Healthcare field and the Technical Trades within Carbon County, Intermountain HealthCare and The Helper Project are providing funding for two ongoing scholarship programs.

To Qualify the applicant must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a Helper, Spring Glen, or Carbonville resident
2. Be a High School graduate
3. Plan to pursue, or are pursuing, a career in the Healthcare field, or one of the vocational/technical trades.
4. Hold a cumulative GPA of 2.5 (either High School or College)
5. Must enroll at USU Eastern for the spring semester

## **Selection Process**

Representatives of The Helper Project will review the applications. Five students will receive \$2,000 and five students will receive \$1,000.

Selection will be based on each student's application and letters of recommendation.
